

Newsletter 2 - Update on LogMaster Project

The European Logistics Association (ELA), along with other Universities and entities, participates in LogMaster, an Erasmus + Project whose goal is to develop an innovative and modern Master's degree program in SCM aligned with the ELA Standards which features the use of digital educational tools. The program is mainly focused on providing a strategic perspective of SCM in the value chain for management positions.

In addition to generating the contents of the program, all partners are engaged in the dissemination of the project. This will be done through activities like multiplier events where some topics will be presented and discussed and the LogMaster project will be introduced.

During the next weeks these multiplier events will be announced by the partners. However you can save the date on the following events:

- **ARILOG annual Conference**, May 15-16, 2025 Bucarest

This conference will address Supply chain challenges in the current economic environment, The future of digitalization and automation in supply chain (Olympus case study), Practical discussion with Romanian authorities about fiscal legislation

- **FH OO, The Upper Austria University of Applied Sciences** will organize a multiplier event on June 12th, 2025. Program will be announced shortly.

- **Heilbronn University, Germany**

The Heilbronn University organizes a Multiplier Event on May 16th, 2025 at their location. In addition to general information about the Logmaster project, results will be shown for the questionnaire about the needs of stakeholders for education in logistics, as well as presenting the digital educational tools and virtual reality systems, the results of the newly developed curriculum and the results of the learning and teaching materials in the e-learning system.
